Dulguun Baatarsukh uses many artistic mediums in often ethereal forms, on a background with bold colors. She creates paintings, installations, and design-clothes to which she adds traditional dolls. Her singular perception of humans and imagination leads her to grant characters in often supernatural forms.

Her art shows a touch of innocence, her works transcribe her dreams and her deep desire to question the world of art and society. Among reflections illustrating her work "Everyone is the continuation of someone else and everyone is the beginning of another" or "We are not able to express what we feel and see," or "Why can not we adorn ourselves with things and immaterial people?".
