

“Hurun India Art List 2020”, a list of the Top 50 living Indian artists

The second edition of the “Hurun India Art List 2020”, features the list of the Top 50 living Indian artists ranked by the sale of their works sold at public auction in the year ending 31 December 2019. Anglo-Indian artist Anish Kapoor, tops the Hurun India Art List 2020 for the second year, with sales of \$ 6 million. Artists Atul Dodiya, and Jitish Kallat, entered the Top 10 for the first time. Atul Dodiya, Rameshwar Broota and Jitish Kallat are the 3 artists on the list who have experienced a significant increase in the value of their works. Raqib Shaw comes fourth on the list with works generating a turnover of \$ 738,876 (8 lots) last year. Of the total artists, 22% are women. Modernist painter Arpita Singh (83) continues to be the most successful Indian female artist. Her works were cumulatively sold at \$ 693,700 the previous year. The youngest in the list is the contemporary artist Valay Shende, 39 years. Subodh Gupta is in 7th place of the list followed by Atul Dodiya. Jitish Kallat (45), one of the young contemporary artists in the Hurun India Art List, holds the tenth position in the List. Contemporary art is the most popular among other artistic styles of artists.
